Best known for the little book Zen Mind, Beginner's Mind, Sharry Suruki was considered the father of Soto Zen in America. This fusi in ography of Suruki, is a delightful portrait of the man by a San Francisco Zen Ceuter student who knew min, well. Based on a thorough review of Suruki's notes and loctures and over 150 interviews with family. Iriends, colleagues, and student as well as his personal knowledge. Chadwick plants a very human, very randid portrait of this "littue" teacher who was so important to the awaketange of America to Eastern spirituality. Nicknamed "Crooked Cotumber" by his boyhood Zec master on account of tas abientifuledness. Suruki demonstrated with his tife how those who appear unsuccessful, int of the ordinary, even not quite with it, may hide great strongth beneath a humble externor. Wonderful accounts of the Zen scene in the 60s and many previously unpublished sayings and leachings fift out this delightful book. AM
