small & brief encounter with
Suzuki-roshi, at Hillside
Center in Portland, in late
1971.

During his lecture at the Sesshin,
he seemed to be talking DIRECTLY
to me, as if my recent activities
& turmoil were as a facial
expression to be plainly read.
This realization increased my
upset greatly. Then, later,

during a break, I was wandering about in Hillside's Calligraphy Studio, alone, still upset ~~at~~ thinking about my half-hearted zazen ~~at~~ calligraphy practices, when I became aware of someone in back of me. I turned around ~~at~~ saw Suzuki-roshi looking at me with great intensity. This lasted perhaps a few seconds but it seemed a very long time. Then he turned away ~~at~~ continued his walk.

Although at the time I could not tell much about what had happened, he had done something to me.

that incident grew in significance
as I noticed the improvement
in the sincerity of my practices.

It is a small thing to give you
as not told so very clearly, but
I cannot say how significant
this small meeting at great
turning-point has been and still
is.


